Objective of the project:	<p><u>Overall objective</u> The overall goal of this programme is to improve the living conditions of the urban poor and contribute to MDG 7 (ensure environmental sustainability), target 7C (halve, by 2015, the proportion of people without sustainable access to safe drinking water and basic sanitation) and target 7D (have achieved by 2020 a significant improvement in the lives of at least 100 million slum dwellers).</p> <p><u>Purposes</u> The project purpose is to strengthen local, national and regional decision-makers, institutional and key urban stakeholders' capacities in slum improvement and prevention by enabling them to identify appropriate responses to increased urbanisation of poverty and to efficiently implement pro-poor urban policies, city-wide slum upgrading strategies and slum upgrading demonstration projects following an approach of three phases.</p>
