<b>Objective of the project:</b>	<p><b><u>Global objective</u></b> To analyse the current system of EUSRs from the management and performance point of view, identify weaknesses and propose improvements.</p> <p><b><u>Specific objectives</u></b></p> <p>1) To analyse the coherence and relevance of the rules that EUSRs have to follow in terms of: Reporting; Financial management; Staff recruitment; Employment</p> <p>2) To analyse the support structures of EUSRs (EEAS and European Commission), in particular compared to the support structures of other CFSP actions both in Brussels and in the field, in terms of: Human resources, including secretarial and administrative support (with a comparison between single and double hatted EUSRs); Logistics; Security; Finance; Synergies with other EU actors</p> <p>3) To carry out a cross-cutting analysis of their budgets to determine the impact in the achievement of their goals of the use of funds for: Staff costs; Missions costs; Running costs; Capital costs; Representation costs</p> <p>4) On the basis of the above points, to assess whether the current system allows EUSRs to carry out their mandate in the most efficient way, and to make proposals on how to improve the system</p>
