This assignment is also expected to reflect on the nature of and the processes involved in trilateral cooperation such as capacity development and technical assistance, and to identify opportunities to improve these programmes/activities.</p> <p>Specific objective/s Some of the specific objectives are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Quantify the trilateral cooperation activities/arrangements in which South Africa has been involved over the last 10 years, clearly indicating which relationships are ongoing. This exercise should reflect on the quantum of resources invested, the sectors supported and the types of development interventions supported through trilateral cooperation. Review the management systems/modalities put in place to allocate, manage, disburse and account for funds as well as the M&E arrangements instituted for the evaluation of trilateral cooperation activities.
Qualifications required:	<p>Qualification and skills</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A minimum of a Master's Degree or relevant post graduate degree in the disciplines related to development – development studies, economics, public or business administration or social sciences Demonstrable research skills and have appropriate skills for the evaluation of development practice and programs Computer literacy and high level writing and presentation skills Able to demonstrate experience/skills in verbal communication and interviewing skills Fluency in English – written and spoken <p>General professional experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At least 12 years of general experience in the development sector. In the absence of a Master's Degree or equivalent, 15 years' general working experience is required. <p>Specific professional experience</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designing and executing research projects within the development sector; Working with multiple stakeholders, including government and international development partners Good knowledge of the ODA and development cooperation environment; Writing research reports Conducting monitoring and evaluation activities/exercises within the developmental sector The collection of primary data through fieldwork, using appropriate research methods e.g. structured and unstructured interviews, focus groups, surveys, etc.; Experience in managing and directing research teams would be preferable and Experience in the Southern African region would be an advantage.
