<b>Qualifications required:</b>	<p><u>Technical tasks to be performed:</u></p> <p>The expert will animate a 5 day training in line with the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Basic concepts and steps involved in certificating an approved maintenance organization.</li> <li>• Five-phase certification process based upon ICAO Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPs). One part shall cover Approved Maintenance Organization (AMO) and a second part shall cover Air Transport Operator Certification (AOC) when the AMO is part of an Air Operator or to be used by the Air Operator.</li> <li>• Set-up of a mock maintenance organization seeking certification so that participants can follow the certification throughout each phase of the certification process.</li> </ul> <p>Practical examples and exercises shall be used and interactive discussion encouraged.</p> <p><u>Specific professional experience</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• C level French speaking according to the Common European Framework of Language;</li> <li>• A minimum of five years' experience working as airworthiness inspector certifying approved maintenance organizations for an EU national aviation authority;</li> <li>• Past experience as a trainer in the field required;</li> <li>• Good knowledge of ICAO requirements;</li> <li>• Extensive experience in operational co-operation activities;</li> <li>• Experience in international and/or multicultural environments;</li> <li>• Good knowledge of the international framework for civil aviation safety regulation;</li> <li>• Proven expertise in summarizing complex situations and conveying key messages to senior management;</li> <li>• Problem solving skills and attention to details;</li> <li>• Good analytical skills and ability to provide clear and concise reports</li> <li>• Good communication skills in English and French, including the ability to produce high quality written material and presentations for a variety of audiences;</li> <li>• Relevant experience in supporting developing countries would be advantageous.</li> </ul>
