Experience beyond 15 years will be accepted, but will not represent an advantage during the evaluation. <p><u>Specific professional experience:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum 5 and up to 10 years of specific experience in OPS rulemaking and/ or inspector experience in the field of OPS. In case of part-time employment, only the actually worked time will be taken into account. Experience beyond 10 years will be accepted, but will not represent an advantage during the evaluation. • Minimum 2 years up to 5 years of specific professional experience in the EU or Member States' Civil Aviation Authority. Experience beyond 5 years will be accepted, but will not represent an advantage during the evaluation. • Field experience in the Eastern Partnership countries, presuming good understanding of local and regional socio-political aspects would be an asset.
