This reform will be directly related to the obligations of the Article 367 of the AAA to "promote efficient, effective and safe transport operations" and Annex XXXII to chapter 7 of the AA listing the relevant EU legislation to be implemented. The purposes of this Contract are as follows: Improve the legal and regulative framework required for reforming the IWW – subsector in relation to the Association; Contribute to the improvement and facilitation of the IWT – subsector in Mol and the related institutions, building overall capacity with an aim to improve the safety, efficiency and effectiveness of IWT – systems in Ukraine, creating the enabling environment in which the IWT industry operates in terms of the effectiveness of sector organization, the market freedoms which it permits, the regulatory constraints it imposes, and the responsiveness with the government and Mol fulfil their functions; Provide a comprehensive IWT facilitation plan for Dnipro River, based on an assessment of the existing transport and freight supply/demand situation in Ukraine and an identification of all infrastructure, institutional, regulatory, environmental, safety and commercial challenges hindering IWT
