Objective of the project:	<p>The main objective of the consultancy service is to develop guidelines/methodology for assessing:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) the impact of development proposals on the Nairobi transport system and ii) for determining and compelling the implementation of measures necessary to mitigate identified adverse impact. <p>This assignment seeks to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stipulate triggers for the requirement to prepare various levels (of complexity) of TIA reports to be prepared or generated in support of planning applications associated with private and/or public developments in Nairobi, including timing of preparation and assessments of reports. • Prepare guidelines/standards and methodology for the preparation and reporting of the various types/levels of TIA • Prepare guidelines for the assessment and appraisal of TIA documents and standard format of reports detailing assessments and appraisals undertaken. • Establish the framework for determining and allocating (between public and private sector) responsibility for interventions necessary to accommodate and/alleviate impact of development proposals • Stipulate competency and/or qualifications of professionals authorised to conduct and assess TIAs • Develop and recommend transport related development control policy to be included/adopted in NCC transport policy, including specific considerations for Transit Oriented Developments (TODs) • Prepare draft bill/laws and regulations in support of above policy to be presented to Nairobi Assembly • Prepare draft standard/sample third party agreements reflecting 'planning gains' • Identify and document resource requirements, capacity necessary within NCC in order to fully implement requirements above and provide training/briefing to key NCC staff.
