Draft new/replacement by-laws and regulations supporting the NCC Transport Policy <p>This assignment seeks to: Develop/articulate a Nairobi Transport Policy, compatible with its recently adopted NMT Policy, which will guide NCC planning and interventions related to all road transport based modes. The policy will provide NCC strategy and detailed recommendations regarding, inter alia:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • road network development and maintenance; • public transport, including: • operations, infrastructure, regulations and investments associated with County intentions to reform existing bus services • introduction of enhanced and modern road based public transport • integration of local public transport operations with rapid mass transit proposals • NMTs • regulation of the rising use of motor-cycle taxis and tuk-tuks and other para-transit systems in Nairobi • movements of goods to, from and within Nairobi. • Prepare draft laws and regulations supporting key/priority aspects of the NCC Transport Policy, which will, as a minimum, include transport sector obligations of NCC, rules on registration and use of all forms of public service vehicles, associated fees and penalties, arbitration mechanisms etc.
