Specific professional experience: Minimum 10 years of experience with both feasibility studies and detailed designs for infrastructure projects, in one or more of the five ERI infrastructure sectors (Environment, Energy, Transport, Social Infrastructure and Digital Economy); 5 years proven experience in working with national administrations of countries in the Southern Neighbourhood region and/or Western Balkans will be regarded as advantageous.
