Objective and purpose of the project:	<p>Support the identification and preparation of technically, financially, economically, environmentally and socially sound investment projects in the sectors of solid waste management, wastewater and storm water management in Sub-Saharan Africa in accordance with EU priorities, supporting and extending existing donor programmes as appropriate.</p> <p>The COPIP Programme will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) identify, assess and prepare solid waste management, wastewater and storm water management projects in Sub-Saharan Africa in the public and private sectors; (ii) define technical assistance support needed for project implementation ; (iii) carry out five pilot scale projects as proof of concept of selected project component(s) or approach(es) to build awareness and commitment among local stakeholders; (iv) disseminate relevant lessons learnt and share knowledge for the benefit of other Sub-Saharan African countries. <p>Specific results will include a pipeline of minimum 20 projects identified, with five projects prepared including Terms of Reference for the project implementation support, as further elaborated in sections 4.1.1 and 4.2.</p>
