Objective and purpose of the project:	<p>The overall objective of the contract is to achieve a shift towards a safer, environmentally friendly transport system reflecting a more balanced modal split. The purpose of this contract is to harmonise Turkish Legislation with Directive 2008/96/EC and enhance capacity at KGM to implement road infrastructure safety management, resulting in enhanced road infrastructure safety management. The expected results are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Support to the harmonisation of Turkish legislation towards Directive 2008/96/EC on road infrastructure safety management. • In order to implement Directive 2008/96/EC, gap analysis and report, legislative documents, guidelines and related documents will be prepared. Furthermore, technical visits to EU Member States will be organised to investigate good practices of the implementation of the Directive. To inform about related activities and progress of the project, workshops for executives and related stakeholders and workshops for indirect target group to be organized. • Enhanced capacity at KGM to implement road infrastructure safety management. • Make a revision of design manuals of KGM, prepare handbooks, training programme and training material for road safety impact assessment (RSIA), road safety audit (RSA), road safety inspection (RSI), network safety management (NSM). Realize trainings (including certification) for KGM personnel on these four subjects and organize site visits including workshops in EU Member State(s) about the implementation of Directive 2008/96/EC and seeing the best practices in site.
Qualifications required:	<p>The Team Leader and Road Safety Expert will manage the implementation of all components of the Project and will assume direct responsibility for coordination, communication as well as the quality control of the Project's outputs. He/she will manage the team of experts, organise all aspects of the technical project work, and ensure good communication with the Steering Committee, Project Coordination and Implementation Unit and Management Committee.</p> <p>He/she will primarily be responsible for all the activities related to implementation of the project: gap analysis (analysis and report of current situation about organisational structure, implementation of Directive 2008/96/EC and legal aspect), harmonization studies, legislation documents, guidelines, technical visits and workshops. In addition, he/she will monitor and guide the work of the Safe Road Design Expert, (about; preparing design manuals, handbooks (for RSIA, RSA, RSI, and NSM), training programme and materials, trainings and site visits). The minimum percentage of time that the he/she will work in Turkey is 90 %.</p> <p><u>Qualifications and skills:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A University degree in business administration, economics, engineering, social sciences, law or natural sciences.
